(Stage 3) Folsom Cyclebration Omnium

Sunday, September 12 • 7:30 a.m.-6:30 p.m.

Course Description

Already a Northern California racing classic, each amazing 1.3 mile lap through historic downtown features two of Folsom's most notable bridges over Lake Natoma: the impressively engineered Lake Natoma Crossing, and the iconic and historical Rainbow Bridge. There is a modest elevation gain/loss in each lap. Solid break-away efforts can pay dividends. Same general course as 2009 with an ample finishing straight-away for sprinters. Great spectating is available along the entire course and in local businesses along the course. Full on-course wheel support provided by Williams Cycling. **This race venue is as beautiful as it is unique and exciting.**

Race Entry

Enter at <http://www.sportsbaseonline.com> until noon on Sept. 8. We highly recommend pre-registration; categories are expected to fill.

Race day registration: add \$5 fee, opens at 6:30 a.m., closes 15 minutes prior to each race. Separate entry per race required. Multiple omnium entries are allowed, but you must complete a time trial for each category. Second race is \$15, day-of registration only. No refunds.

Held rain or shine under USAC/NCNCA rules/permit. Under 18 y/o requires parent or legal guardian signature.

All racers need to complete the release form (http://www.usacycling.org/forms/riders_release.pdf) and City of Folsom Liability Release form at check-in.

USAC license required. No license, no race, no exceptions. Cat 5 men and Cat 4 women may use one-day license. Entry fee includes USAC insurance and NCNCA surcharges. 2010 champs pay \$10. If pre-registered for the race, promoter will refund the pre-registration difference on race day.

Prizes for Circuit Race The Two Bridges Circuit Race total purse is in excess of \$1,600 – 100% CASH all races. Prizes for each race range from a minimum of \$70 to \$250. (See website for specific prize amounts for each race.) Category 5 men and juniors receive medals only.

The Omnium purse is in addition to prizes awarded for each race. Total Omnium purse is \$6,000. Prizes for each Omnium category range from \$150 to \$1,600. (See website for specific prize amounts for each category.)

The Folsom South Canal Time Trial is part of the Endurance Point Series. The Folsom Challenge Criterium and Two Bridges Circuit Race are part of the Cycles Falcon Top Flyer Award. Winners of the Top Flyer competition will receive their awards on Sunday, September 12 during the circuit race.

Directions to Event From Sacramento – Highway 50: exit Folsom Blvd; turn left (north) on Folsom Blvd; follow signage – right exit on Sutter Street/Historic District; immediate left on Reading Street; park in parking structure. Additional parking available off Sutter Street – look for directional signs. WATCH height limit and bikes on roof mounted carriers when driving into the parking structure.
